progressed, they voted Jane Geiger as the Quartermaster of the group.




The Obstacle Course



Our Ministry Grace Ministries offers a strong variety of services.

Counseling

The Counselors of Grace Ministries are available to help those serving as caregivers, and also to our combat veterans and their families.

Massage Therapy

Helping Save Marriages

Until reading this page, you might have considered **mediation** only as a way to settle court cases and finalize divorces.

Mission Mediation offers mediation to help married couples resolve their differences and remain married. Although it's unusual, it can work and Grace Ministries works to help couples stay together. Mission Mediation offers three trained, experienced mediators in Alabama and Tennessee to respectfully resolve and restore broken relationships and disputes.

We offer three types of marriage mediation. In addition to the marriage-saving mediation, we also offer pre-marital mediation

to help couples identify and address issues that can become problematic after the marriage. In some cases, either one or both do not even realize that the issues exist. Our third type of mediation, as a last resort, is to help the parties to a divorce resolve their case without the need for a lengthy, expensive, and damaging courtroom trial.

Our mediators will also assist with matters involving civil litigation, probate, child custody, corporate dissolutions, real property, and issues arising from criminal cases.







Nestled in a corner upstairs room of a stately yellow Victorian home near Cobb Lane, Grace Ministries launched its ministry to the diverse population of the South Side, as well as friends and clients of Jane Geiger. Other Team Grace members included Alicia Scott, Scot Simmons, and Michele Willis. C.P. Bagby served as the first Executive Director.

1996

Also in 1996, the women of Grace Ministries launched their prayer time on certain Sunday nights, seeking God's grace and powerful presence for healing and soaring in the Grace Ministries village, in the lives of friends and family, and in their own lives. Those powerful and holy times continue today.

1996

Grace Ministries, Inc. became an officially recognized nonprofit, obtaining 501-c-3 status from the United States government.

In an unassuming, secondstory space about a shoe store, Grace Ministries launched its 17-year ministry in Homewood. The signature fireplace scene became the venue for countless moments of healing and personal renewal.



2010

The 15th year of Grace Ministries also brought the entry of Grace Ministries into the world of publishing. Dr. Geiger's three-book-series has comforted and inspired countless readers. 2008

It's an easy number to remember: 6-7-8. On June 7, 2008, the leader and founder of Grace Ministries became DR. Jane Geiger, as she earned her Doctorate from Ashland Theological Seminary in Ashland, Ohio. The seemingly endless drives from Homewood to Ashland finally bore fruit. So too, did the walls of her home covered with those oversized Post-It notes, giving her a macro-view of her dissertation-in-progress.



2010

The BLUSH Magazine column began, giving thousands of readers the regular advice from its columnist "Dr. Jane" from then until the magazine's last issue in 2017.

2011

A racially-charged event brought unfavorable and national attention to the University of Alabama, and Grace Ministries sprang into action. A heated verbal exchange between a fraternity member and a star Crimson Tide football player resulted in unfortunate words shouted. The office of the university's president asked Dr. Jane Geiger to conduct a meaningful day of healing and moving forward with the entire fraternity.

2011

The Grace Ministries Chattanooga ministry moved into its highly popular location at 50 Frazier Avenue, on the trendy North Shore, at the foot of the city's iconic pedestrian bridge. One of America's greatest walking cities remains an important hub for Grace Ministries' clients and the place of many saved marriages and seasons of personal renewal.



2011

The year also brought the launch of the Compassionate Care ministry, and the timing could not have been better. Shortly after the ministry was rolled into action, led by Duane Wade, Wes Fortner, and Jane Geiger, a deadly outbreak of tornados devastated many areas of Alabama.

2012

In a world where unresolved conflict often leads to broken families, mediation has become an increasingly important tool to reconcile people and extinguish conflict. Mission Mediation, founded by attorney Helen Ball and Dr. Jane Geiger, has helped successfully mediate many conflicts that appeared hopeless.

2017

The Grace Ministries radio ministry became a recurring event, on Birmingham's TALK 99.5 FM. Guest appearances soon gave rise to guest hosting, as Dr. Jane became a source for insight into peaceful living.

2019

As Grace Ministries prepares to enter its 25th year, its ministry continues expanding. Three new book releases, set for the next year, will once again become the Grace Ministries outreach to a world that needs them. Team Grace eagerly awaits the release of **Social Media Sanity**, **The Obstacle Course**, and **Peaceful Warrior** (Patient Care Advocate).



2018

The foundation for a future ministry began, as work commenced to create Grace Models, Inc., a modeling agency promoting stylish and elegant beauty.
